

Using OneClickDigital for Audiobooks



OneClickDigital is a service that provides audiobooks for library patrons. We subscribe through the Utah State Library. OneClickDigital has audiobooks from Recorded Books. The service works similarly to Overdrive but there are fewer license restrictions and very few items have hold lists. To explore what is available, visit the site: pioneer.utah.gov and choose OneClickDigital Audiobooks.

OneClickDigital can be used with computers, either Windows or Mac, by downloading the OneClick-Digital MediaManager. Or, it can be used with a variety of mobile devices (smart phones, tablets, etc) by visiting your device's app store and downloading the OneClickDigital eAudio App. Great information and video tutorials can be found at this address:

Before using your OneClickDigital App, visit the site. Go to pioneer.utah.gov, then choose OneClick-Digital Audiobooks and select your library when prompted. When the site opens, click on "Create New Account," in the upper right hand corner of the page. You will need your library barcode to do this. Be sure to record your account information.

Once your account is created, you can open and log into the app on your mobile device. Follow the prompts to search or click on "Library Site," to browse. When you find a title, choose "Checkout Now." Find the tab at the top of the page that says "My Collections," then "Download Now." Once this is completed, you return to your bookshelf by choosing "My Titles" from the top left corner of the page. Finally, click on the download arrow to transfer the files to your device. When you see all the files have been downloaded, you can listen to your book. Items will return automatically at the end of your loan period. Renewal or early return is easy. From the "My Titles" page, simply click on the *i* button next to each title and choose renew or return as desired.
