What is the Orem Teen Library Council?

OTLC is a group of teens in grades 7-12 that meet once a month in the library to plan teen programs, get volunteer experience through library service projects, and gain access to many behind-the-scenes experiences in the library.

Why should you join OTLC?

- Get involved in the behind-the-scenes of the library
- Gain leadership, volunteer, and service experience that look great on future college and job applications
- Check out media materials for free
- Receive letters of recommendation from the OTLC Advisor and other librarians for college and job applications
- Gain leadership experience by serving on the OTLC presidency when you are 14 years or older

What are the responsibilities of OTLC members?

Members of OTLC:

- Attend monthly OTLC meetings
- Perform a minimum of 22 hours of service in the library outside of OTLC meetings each academic year. 11 hours need to be completed between July and December, the first half of the academic year. The other 11 hours need to be completed between January and June.
- Assist with planning and preparing Teen After Hours programs
- Help decorate and maintain the Teen Zone
- Write recommendations about library items for teen patrons
